

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATION Effective June 15, 2022

The Tennessee Ryan White Part B Program requires clients to have their eligibility determined at their initial enrollment, reenrollment and annually. Clients must provide proof of eligibility and sign all eligibility documentation.

- 1. Ryan White Part B Program clients can certify annually.
 - Clients who have a full recertification as of June 1, 2022, can be certified annually.
 - Case managers must select the "Annual Certification" checkbox in RWES to ensure all notifications will calculate annually.
 - Annual certification can be completed on any date prior to the required certification date.
 - Clients who fail to certify annually will be disenrolled from the program and required to reenroll with all required eligibility documents signed. Central Office can grant exceptions for emergency situations.
 - Utilization of electronic signatures for annual certifications is acceptable.
 - Clients certifying annually must have one in-person visit within the certification year annotated in CAREWare. Video telehealth can be used as an in-person visit.
 - Clients cannot use self-attestation when certifying annually unless given an exception by Central Office.
- 2. Clients who need to recertify after June 1, 2022 and are unable to conduct a full certification.
 - Can recertify using self-attestation. Next certification must be a full certification.
 - Can have services suspended for 45 days before being disenrolled from the program.
 - Clients who have been disenrolled will be required reenroll with all required documents signed. Central Office can grant exceptions for emergency situations.
 - 3. Case managers who choose to have clients recertify every 6 months must coordinate with Central Office.
 - Case managers will not select the "Annual Certification" checkbox in RWES for these clients.
 - Case managers must include a note on the RWES enrollment page stating the type of recertification being completed.
 - 4. The suspended services option in RWES will be discontinued on June 1, 2023.
